Harbour and Grey Seals are often hauled out on our secluded rocky outcrops, and moose, bears, bald eagles, cormorants, guillemots, gannets and loons are frequently seen. The scenery on its own is breathtaking, with our spectacular rock and cliff formations, mysterious sea caves, waterfalls, abandoned cove settlements, a Tibetan Buddhist monastery, colourful fishermen, and much more!!!
