# RESEARCH VESSEL

## DOUBLE HOOKUP

Our boat the "Double Hookup", a 42 foot Whale Watcher, is equipped with a spotting tower to increase our success rate. With top speed twice as fast as others, we spend more time watching the whales and less time getting there.

The vessel is Coast Guard certified, has an easily accessible ramp, is partly covered and has a washroom. On board we provide binoculars, seasickness aids and raincoats.

On our research vessel each tour benefits from experienced, professional guides and researchers from Dalhousie University. It is fully narrated with information about sea life and local history. Our researchers will be more than happy to answer any questions regarding their studies.
